ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for this scholarship, each applicant **must** meet the following criteria:

For High School students:

- Recipient must be a US citizen or legal resident of the State of California.
- Recipient must have a permanent disability.
- Recipient on track to graduate by June 2015
- Recipient must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- Recipient must be planning a career in a transportation related field of study, i.e., engineering, surveying, planning, drafting, computer science, business administration, landscaping, environmental planning or right of way.

For College students:

- Recipient must be a US citizen or legal resident of the State of California.
- Recipient must have permanent disability.
- Recipient must currently be enrolled in 6 semester or 9 quarter units.
- Recipient must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- Recipient must be enrolled in a transportation related field of study, i.e., engineering, surveying, planning, drafting, computer science, business administration, landscaping, environmental planning or right of way.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

Each applicant must submit the following materials:

- 1. A completed Disability Advisory Committee/California Transportation Foundation Scholarship Application.
- 2. An essay outlining career goals (not to exceed 500 words).
- 3. For high school students, latest report card.
- 4. For college students, official transcripts.
- 5. A minimum of two sealed letters of recommendation
 - One from faculty
 - One from a supervisor, friend or pastor.

SELECTION AND ANNOUNCEMENT

The DAC Scholarship Committee will review all applications. After careful review, two winners will be notified. The scholarship recipients will be acknowledged in various newsletters including the Caltrans newsletter Freeways and Faces and the California Transportation Foundation. Target award date: **August 17, 2015**.

DEADLINE

The completed application with original signatures must be postmarked by **July** 1, 2015. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

Note: faxed documents are not considered originals.
